Today, consisting of over 3,500 members or "Ganders" in groups or "<u>Ponds</u>" across the United States and Canada, the Blue Goose has a long and storied history. Although each Pond has its' own unique flavor, the Cardinal Principles of character, charity and fellowship are part of every Pond.

During initiation, the new Ganders learned of the secret *key honk* (password) and a secret *salutation* that have existed since the flight of the first Blue Goose on June 19, 1906.
