The Honorable Order of the Blue Goose was founded in 1906 at the annual meeting of the Wisconsin Field Men's Club held at the Oakwood Hotel in Green Lake, Wisconsin. Today, consisting of 3142 members or "Ganders" in 36 groups or "Ponds" across the United States and Canada, the Blue Goose has a long and storied history of both charity and fellowship. The 1st "Bulletin" was published in 1908, the annual publications have continued to this day with news and information about both the Blue Goose and insurance related industry.



THE BEGINNINGS OF THE TEXAS POND WAS ON JANUARY 30, 1907!

- ❖ At the time of the first charter there were 132 ganders in the Texas pond.
- Charter was surrendered in 1914.
- 2nd Charter was granted on January 14, 1921.
- ❖ The 2nd time around there were 190 Ganders in the Texas Pond.
- ❖ Following the issuance of the 2nd Charter the Texas Pond was divided into four Ponds: South Texas (Houston); Alamo Pond (San Antonio); West Texas (Lubbock); and three Puddles: Austin, El Paso & Corpus Christi.
- **❖** In 1992, the 2nd Charter was surrendered.
- ❖ The 3rd Charter was issued at the Grand Nest Convention in New York City in 1995.
