The membership selected Wayne Ottoway & Ashley Hansen to be the Texas Pond Delegates for the 116th Grand Nest Convention.

Discussion was had by the members regarding the Dues Amendment that will be presented at the Grand Nest Convention. It is proposed that the Grand Nest dues go from \$27 per active member to \$39 per active member, effective July 1, 2022. Of the 13 members present, 12 voted to agree to this increase and one vote was cast against.

The two Texas Delegates will cast affirmative votes on behalf of the Texas Pond at the convention.

The Honorable Order of the Blue Goose was founded in 1906 at the annual meeting of the *Wisconsin Field Men's Club* held at the Oakwood Hotel in Green Lake, Wisconsin. Today, consisting of 3500 members or *"Ganders"* in 40 groups or *"Ponds"* across the United States and Canada, the Blue Goose has a long and storied history of both charity and fellowship. The 1st *"Bulletin"* was published in 1908, the annual publications have continued to this day with news and information about both the Blue Goose and insurance related industry.
