Sharon Wilkins was the 2021-2022 MLG. The Texas Pond honored her with a PMLG pin for her year of service.




With school about to restart our August charity event was focused on collecting school supplies for Community Partners of Dallas. This is our 7th year of supporting the programs of Community Partners.
