This "WISH CARD" campaign is much like the Angel Tree program in the malls and overseen by the Salvation Army.


We have obtained 25 "WISH CARDS" with a \$20.00 or less toy request from some of the children. See the sample card below.

**On The Border:4855 Belt Line Road on December 5th from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm




Wish cards are unique. If lost, they cannot be replaced.
