Community Partners of Dallas has been one of our charity focus organizations since 2016-2017 Blue Goose year. We have contributed to their "Back To School"; "Wish Cards" "Toy Drive' and "Easter Basket" programs for several years. In total we have provided over \$20,000 toward the needs of their programs.







These cozy, private rooms are used for emergency overnights when a case worker cannot place a child with a relative. Each little room with a bed resembles a small home. This allows for the case worker to seek a foster care placement if a relative cannot be located.

All items in the Rainbow Room are new. Case workers can shop, grab, assemble the needs for a child or the family.





CDP uses their funds to buy and keep the room stocked. Individuals can also help supply needed items, such as formula, diapers, shoes. Clothes, etc. for infants to teenagers.

Fifteen Ganders and one guest, soon to be a Gosling, met at Maple Landing to celebrate the end of our Blue Goose year.














The Highlights of the June meeting!
